





The international summer school for observing, assimilating and forecasting the ocean is a two week program offered to early career scientists, professionals and students on the current state of the art in operational oceanography and related advances in the ocean sciences. The course curriculum will include topics covering the leading edge science in ocean observing systems, as well as the latest methods and techniques for analysis, data assimilation and ocean modelling. Emphasis will be given to, operational ocean forecasting systems and their application.



The summer school will be held in Perth, the capital city of Western Australia. Perth city is located on the Swan River with the wider metropolitan areas extending to the coastline. Perth is known for its warm/dry climate, surf beaches and parks. The summer school will be convened at The University of Western Australia.
